COURSE NEWSLETTER

August 2021 Newsletter

As I write this, we are into day 4 of the lockdown, it is very eerie working on the course with no golfers. It has amazed me how much the playing areas have recovered after such a short amount of time without the traffic we have been getting across the course. All of the tees have benefited from the lack of traffic and the putting green, 3rd green, and the 12th green are recovering at a rapid pace. We were lucky enough to get a few warm nights at the start of the lockdown which has also helped. We are running at half a crew to just keep everything in good condition, so we are ready to have the course open for play as soon as we get the green light from the government.

Even though we have had a very long winter with very little break from the cooler weather, all of our playing surfaces are in very good shape. The greens have come through winter as good as I have seen them whilst keeping a very good pace. The tees are getting worn in spots which is to be expected, but overall look good and we still have areas to choose from the use. The fairways still look great and we have been aerating many areas that are getting affected by tree roots.

The Ekka westerlies kicked in a little earlier this year causing the course to get covered by leaves and plant debris which adds a great deal of extra time to our day-to-day maintenance. Greens, tees and fairways cannot be cut until the bulk of the debris is removed and the same goes for raking the bunkers. Our volunteers are always willing to lend a hand after the wind and their assistance is invaluable.

A small but dedicated crew of the volunteers have made finding and repairing any drainage issues in the bunkers their life goal, and so far they have achieved their goals. They have worked on almost half of our 68 bunkers and carried out some very minor to very complex works. There is still some outstanding work we need to carry out now that we have our excavator repaired.

Hopefully we will see an end to the current lock down sooner than later and winter comes to an end.

FROM THE CAPTAIN.

We finally now are seeing weather conditions that are pleasant to play golf in. It's stating the obvious that recent weather conditions have been unusual for this time of year with high winds, very cold temps, and lots of rain it has been a challenge to both play the course at times and keep maintenance up to the course. In saying this though I believe that the course has never looked better for this time of the year which is credit to both the Green Staff and of course to the band of volunteers who turn up twice a week in all weather and do whatever needs to be done at the time.

We recently took delivery of a new greens mower which has been in use now for around four weeks and it is no coincidence that our greens have never run smoother or faster than they do now.

The volunteers in particular Don Henry and Lee Madsen have been putting in a great deal of time in carrying out drainage work in and around the bunkers, the results of which are that the bunkers now drain a lot faster after rain. The added benefit of this work is the hours saved for the green staff in not having to pump out bunkers after rain events. Many thanks to them again.

Many of you would have noticed the large piles of soil being dumped to the righthand side of the seventh green and are curious to know what is happening here. At this stage all we can say is that we have significant plans for this area which will be published in a document for distribution in the near future.

You will have noted that a number of large pine trees around the course are dying off. It is not because of some disease, rather they have come to end of their life span. We have a program to remove them which the Volunteers are carrying out. As these trees are removed, we will be looking at the types of trees suitable for our course conditions to replace them with.

The work currently been carried out in the fairway bunker on the right-hand side of the 11th holes will see the current bunker go with a "grass bunker replacing it.
