#### **DRIVING RANGE**

Just a couple of reminders regarding the use of the driving range....

- Please only hit from between the ropes when using the main driving range area regardless of if you are hitting down the range or back to the short game green. The ropes are there to provide maintenance for the rest of the range to allow the grass to regrow for use.
- No woods are to be used on the range. The main reason for this is safety of your fellow golfers. The ball is travelling faster when hit by a wood and for player safety on the 5<sup>th</sup> hole and 9<sup>th</sup> hole we ask that you please abide by this rule.
- The tee at the far end of the range is for PGA Coaching only. If you are seeing one of the team for lessons you may end up using that end but it is only for lessons, not general practice.
- We are currently experiencing a large loss of range balls and baskets. This is a reminder that when you hire a basket and range balls they are for your use on **that day only**. Please don't hold on to unused balls and baskets as this creates a shortage for your fellow members. If you are currently holding range balls and or baskets would you kindly return them to the golf shop

• The driving range is a part of the golf course and as such the dress regulations remain the same as if you were heading out on course or clubhouse. Please make sure you follow the club dress regulations as posted on the board outside the Proshop.
