



Gailes Golf Club Code of Conduct For all Members, Guests and Visitors

The Code of Conduct provides members, guests and visitors with guidance on the standards of behaviour, care and relationships that are expected of them while they are on the club premises and golf course.

It has been developed by the Club to ensure everyone can enjoy amenities provided by the Club in a safe, enjoyable and responsible manner.

Accordingly, Members, Guests and Visitors shall:

- Respect the rights of others to enjoy the Club's facilities and services.
- Interact with each other, the Club's employees and volunteers in a courteous manner.
- Not engage in behaviour towards each other, the Club's Staff and Employees and volunteers that is intended to abuse, harass, discriminate or instruct.
- Refrain from disorderly or disruptive behaviours.
- Show due consideration to the needs of others, including their right to privacy.
- Comply with Club policies, signage and lawful directions by Staff and Employees.
- Conform with the Dress Code of the Club (available upon request and displayed in the clubhouse).
- Not bring alcoholic drinks onto the club premises or golf course for consumption.
- Not bring or have in their possession illegal substances or materials while on club premises or golf course.
- Not wilfully damage any property, installation or equipment provided by the Club.
- Not remove, move or relocate any materials, equipment and fixtures unless authorised to do so.
- Refrain from representing the club, unless properly authorised to do so
- Not pursue personal agendas on club premises or golf course without prior permission.
- Not deliberately tarnish the reputation of the club or bring it into disrepute either in person, digital correspondence or social media.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct either expressed or implied may be dealt with in accordance with the Club Rules and may result in suspension or cancellation of membership.
